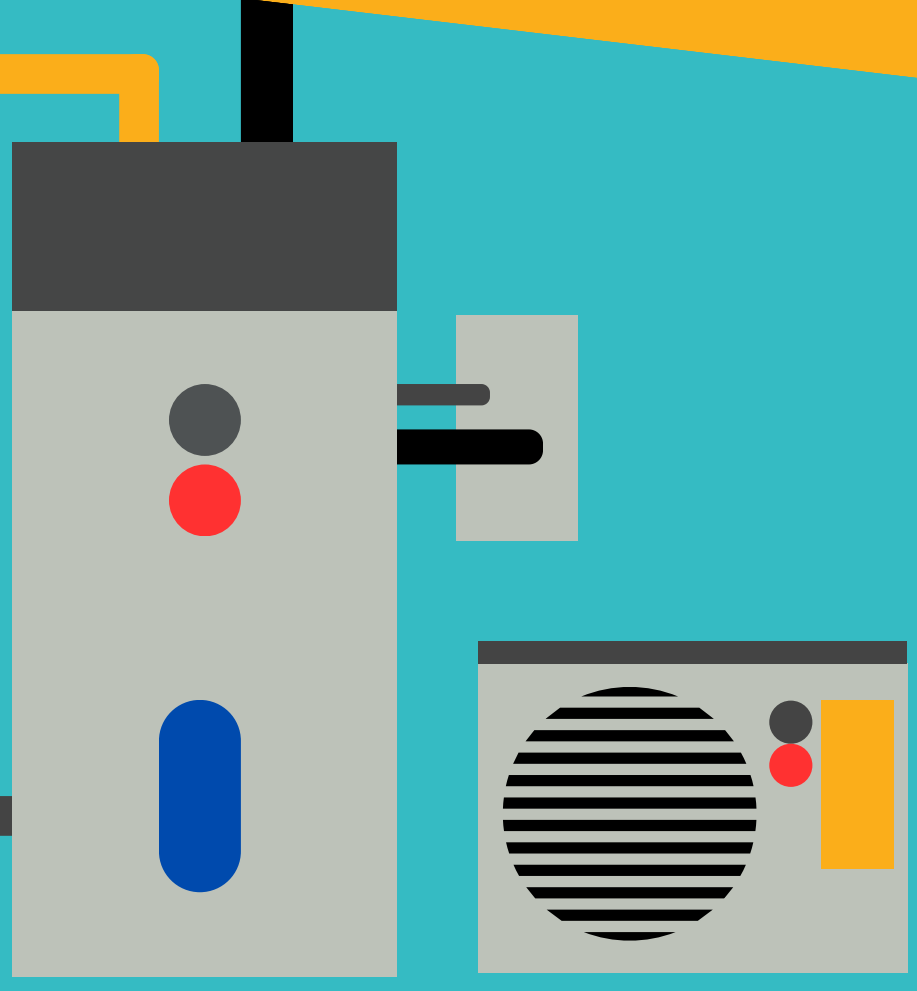


WEATHERIZATION + ELECTRIFICATION IN MINNESOTA



In Minnesota, the state agency in charge of administering the Home Energy Rebate Program is the Minnesota Commerce Department (MNCOMM)

Current Status in Minnesota:

In March '24, MNCOMM applied for the HEAR Program and it continues to work on developing its program. As of June '24, it has not submitted a HER/HOMES Program application.

Public Engagement Opportunities

MNCOMM is hosting a series of public informational meetings.



Process Timeline

- Mid '23 - MNCOMM received DOE funds for program planning
- Mid '23 to early '24 - program planning and design
- Mid '24 - submit program application to DOE
- Mid '24 to late '24 - DOE approves program and awards funds to start program
- Late '24 to early '25 - build & implement program
- 2025 - MNCOMM opens program to households
- Program runs through 2032 or until all funds are used, whichever is earlier.

We are awaiting further clarification on:

- Requirements for contractor certification
- Process for validating income levels
- Requirements for data/audit verification
- Overlap with other Minnesota state programs, including Heat Pump Rebates and Electric Panel Upgrade Grants

Launch Timeline:

As of June '24, MNCOMM does not have a precise estimate for program launch date.
